1. In case of a medical emergency dial **911**. Someone familiar with the park should be sent to the park access to guide the emergency responders to the emergency location.
2. The park address is **480 Kings Fork Road**.
3. First aid kits are located in both conex boxes should minor injuries occur. There is one conex box by the gazebo and one by the archery range.
4. The park access gate is to remain unlocked during the event to allow emergency responders access should they be needed.
5. There is no wading or swimming allowed in the pond. The area around the pond is uneven, can be slippery, and slopes towards the pond. Be careful of your footing and watch children carefully when near the pond.
6. Point out the location of outhouses and remind participants that there is no photography allowed in the immediate area of the outhouses.
7. Participants must remain on walking paths when traversing the park.
8. Ticks, mosquitoes and other biting bugs are in the park. Use bug repellent if you have it and be sure to check yourself and children after the event for ticks.
9. Wildlife lives in the park. Do not feed any animals or disturb their homes or nesting sites. Do not try to capture or chase any animal.
10. Remind parents/guardians that they are required to maintain control of their children at all times.
